

Clean Athletics Summary of Activities 2021-2022

Clean Athletics Board Member Appointed

David Marrs, former NI international sprinter and 2020 Sport NI Technical Official of the Year has been appointed by the Athletics NI Management Board as the Clean Athletics member of the board. David has completed his designated board member 'Clean Athletics Education' and will work with Clean Sport Lead Tom Reynolds on the implementation of Athletics NI's Clean Athletics Strategy.

Assurance Framework Update

Athletics NI is working to compete the UKAD Assurance Framework process which is to be submitted by 1 April Deadline. We currently comply with the majority of the Framework and are working with UKAD, British Athletics and the Home Country Athletic Federations to complete the final elements.

Clean Sport Strategy and Implementation Plan Update

Athletics NI is working with British Athletics and Home Country Athletic Federations to adopt a joint Clean Athletics Strategy and complete individual Implementation Plans for this strategy. On completion both documents will be posted on this webpage.

Education Overview

Birmingham Commonwealth Games Clean Games Education Programme – Long list athletes are currently completing the programme with over 80% having completed the Clean Sport 1 or Olympic Top Up online education elements. Selected athletes will undergo face to face Clean Games education during our Commonwealth Preparation Games Programme weekend in June.

Erasmus education – Athletes on the Erasmus Camp in April will undergo Clean Sport Education from a qualified educator as per previous camps.

I Run Clean Programme – All athletes competing in European U20 and U23 Championships 2021 in Tallinn underwent the I Run Clean online Anti-Doping education produced by European Athletics
